MEDICATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE

Any student who <u>must</u> take medication during regular school hours must do so in compliance with this school's regulations and the governing laws of the state.

For over-the-counter (OTC) medication:

- Written request/consent signed by parent/guardian
- Medication must be sent in <u>original container</u>—NO BAGGIES or FOIL-WRAPPED, LOOSE UNIDENTIFIED medicine

For prescription medication to be given for less than two (2) weeks:

- Written request/consent signed by parent/guardian
- Must be in <u>original</u> container
- Prescription label must have student's name
- 4. Must be properly labeled by a registered pharmacist as prescribed by law

For prescription medication given for longer than two (2) weeks:

- 1. A form from the nurse's office must be completed by parent and physician
- No medication will be given until this or a similar physician's form is received.
- 3. This is to be updated annually
- 4. Must be in original container
- 5. Prescription label must have student's name
- 6. In case dosage changes, we must receive a written prescription from physician
