CLASS PROCEDURES

- Enter the classroom quietly and quickly, and be at your desk working on your bellringer within 5 minutes of the start of class.
- No cell-phones and smart watches are allowed to be used during class time and they must be turned OFF. My recommendation is to keep them at home. There is a designated pouch in class to place these items if you have them with you. You can pick them up when you leave at the end of the day. I will not be responsible for any items left in my classroom.
- If you were absent, check the designated "while you were out folder" for any
 work that you need to catch up on, or your Google Classroom. (3 DAYS TO
 COMPLETE) THIS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!!!
- If you have a question, quietly raise your hand and I will come to you or call on you. If you need to leave your seat, raise your hand.
- If you finish your work early, you may start on your homework, do any makeup work that you need to complete, or read quietly. This is not a time to socialize. You must be working until class is dismissed.
- We will be using Chromebooks and Google classroom occasionally.
- It is your responsibility to come to class prepared by having your binder, homework (if applicable), and writing utensils.
- When class is over, you must wait for me to dismiss you with our "holla back" statement HOOKED ONSCIENCE!
- Stop and Look before you Leave. Is your stool/chair pushed under your desk?
 Do you have all of your supplies? Is your work turned in?

DISCIPLINE

- 1st Offense: Warning with Redirection
- 2nd Offense: Warning with Redirection and Time Out and Parents will be notified through the Remind App
- 3rd Offense: You will be written up and parents will be notified. School policies will be followed as far as After School Detention, etc.

<u>GRADING</u>

- Grades will consist of daily assignments, quizzes, and tests.
- Daily assignments = 40% (classwork, homework, notebook checks, and labs)
- Quizzes & Tests = 60% (quizzes may be given at any time and will cover recent materials and concepts)
- Tests will be announced and students will be given time to study.
- Projects may be assigned throughout the year with reasonable deadlines and will count as a test grade.

RETAKE POLICY

If a student receives a failing grade on any assignment, they will be given an opportunity to retake that assignment following these guidelines:

- Retake and make-up work must be returned within 3 days of return or notification. NO EXCEPTIONS
- The highest grade possible for a retake is a 70.
- It is the student's responsibility to complete and return assignments on time.

WHAT DO I DO IF I AM ABSENT?

If you are absent, it is your responsibility to obtain all make-up work. YOU WILL HAVE 3

DAYS TO TURN IN YOUR ASSIGNMENT. NO EXCEPTIONS!

All make-up work can be obtained from the daily "while you were out" folders for the appropriate grade AND/OR in your Google Classroom.
